HISTORY AND MEMBERSHIP

History - The Electric League of the Pacific Northwest is an association of electrical industry businesses in the Pacific Northwest with the mission of “promoting the common business interests and improving the business conditions of the electrical industry.” For most of a century there has been an active electrical group in the Puget Sound area with the earliest records dating from 1916 and eventually incorporated as the Electric League in 1968. In 2001 the Inland Electrical League in Spokane joined forces with the Electric League in order to better serve the region.

Membership - The Electric League has proven to be a valuable association for its members. Membership is composed of electrical contractors, distributors, manufacturers, manufacturer’s reps or agents, consulting engineers, utilities and allied associates. In fact, just about anyone who has anything to do with the electrical industry is, or should be, a member of the Electric League.

INDUSTRY UPDATES

Keeping members informed is one of the League’s most vital roles. The League distributes electronic news to all League members. Electrical News is a combination of local news, information about League programs, activities, and members; plus regional and national news emanating from NECA, NEMA, IES, IEEE and other associations or groups whose activities have an impact on Electric League members.
