Overview of upcoming changes to the Washington State Energy Code (WSEC)

### Reports

**State of Washington** Dennis Straley

- 2020 NEC adopted as of Oct 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Exemptions and specific code delays below:
  - 210.8(F) – Outdoor GFCI protection (Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023).
  - 210.8(A)(7) – GFCI receptacles rated 30-50A within six feet of sink (Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023).
  - 230.71 – Service Equipment for temp power, recreational vehicles and other applications (July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021).
- Temporary allowance for Trainees to work while completing classroom training due to COVID-19 classroom restrictions.
- Reciprocal agreement with Oregon for Journey-Level electricians.

- Adoption date for 2018 SEC (Seattle Energy Code): March 15th, 2021.
  - Permit Package that contains the above ground structural will be used to determine which energy code is enforced.
