City of Seattle/Dave Rankin

Seattle Electric Code goes into effect on November 15, 2024.

The city continues to see more office conversions to multi-family units.

A plethora of energy storage systems are being installed in Seattle. The Seattle Fire Department is taking a close look at these systems to make sure they're safe. PV systems rated 12KW and above must be reviewed by SFD. SFD has also weighed in on EV chargers and has asked for a safety disconnect within 25 feet of chargers.

Snohomish PUD/Rob Marks

SnoPUD received a 30 million grant from DOE for grid resilience. This grant will be used for lower income/less served communities. It will help fund quick switching and wildfire resilience.
