Snohomish PUD/Rob Marks

Growth in Snohomish County continues and the outlook is favorable.

The new I-Energy platform is working well. It is now easier for contractors to submit plans online. Over the next six weeks, Snohomish County PUD is distributing one-time \$200 bill credits to assist low- and moderate-income PUD residential customers. SnoPUD was awarded nearly \$14 million in funding, enough to provide bill credits to nearly 70,000 of the PUD's more than 340,000 residential customers. The PUD was awarded an additional \$5.3 million in funding, the most of any utility in the state, as part of Commerce's Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates Program. Also leveraging resources from the Climate Commitment Act, this program will distribute free energy-efficient appliances, including washers, dryers, induction cooktops, and heat pump water heaters to qualifying customers.
